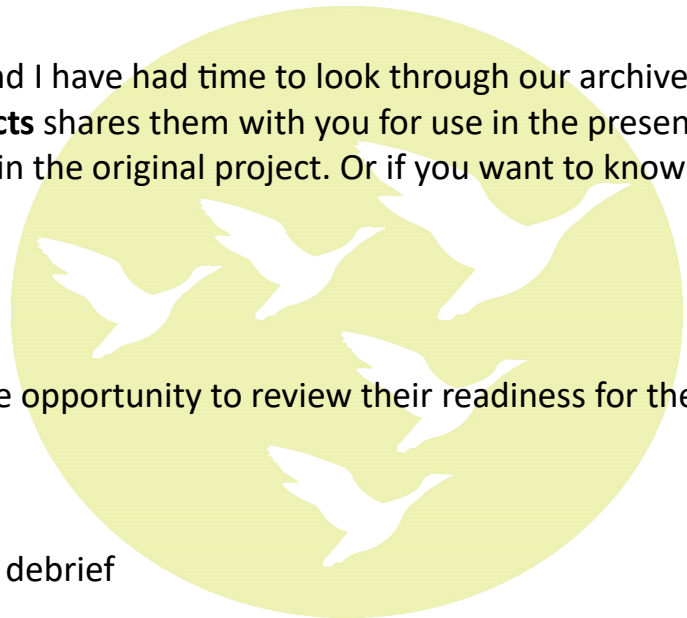
## ETConnects
