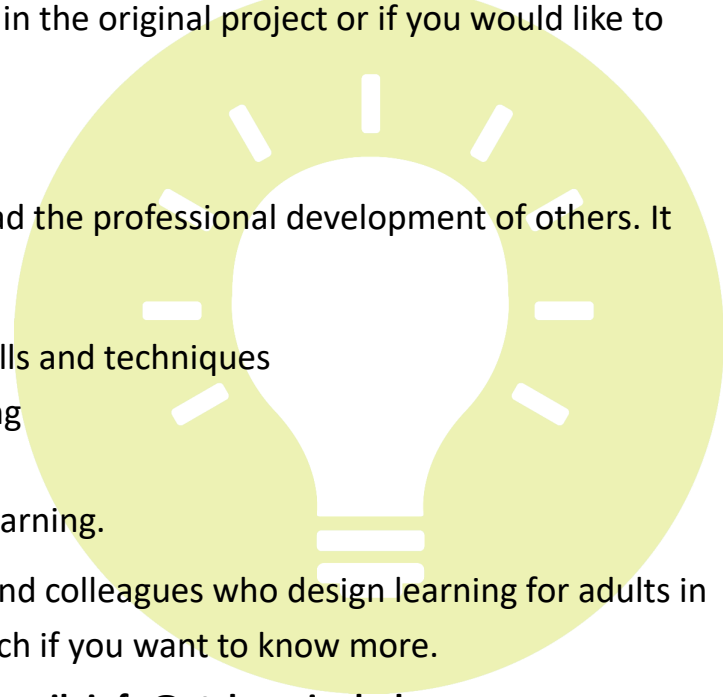
Facilitation Matters (launched in 2015)
